

SIHM, Boys Residence

1. General Information

State Institute of Hotel Management, Udaipur has accommodation to limited number of male students of first semester of B.Sc. (HHA) only.

2. Admission

A. Students seeking admission in the hostel must apply on line through NCHMCT counseling and contact to the office of the institute administration.

3. Code of Conduct

A. On arrival a student will report to the warden and after completing necessary medical and other formalities, student will take possession of the room after signing the inventory of the furniture, electrical and other items in the room.

B. At the end of each semester, the students shall vacate his room with in three days after the final examination of the course is over and hand over the charge of the room including all items, on the inventory to the care taker or any other official of the hostel authorized by the warden.

C. The following acts/items are forbidden inside the hostel premises:

- a. Ragging in any form
- b. Any act of intimidation or violence
- c. Willful damage to the property
- d. Drinking or riotous behavior
- e. Use or consumption of narcotics or alcoholic beverages.
- f. Gambling
- g. Smoking
- h. Use of unauthorized electrical gadgets.
- i. Cooking/ making tea etc.
- j. Pasting of posters, writing on walls or defacing the hostel in any form.
- k. Shouting, calling out, whistling or singing a loud.
- l. Fire arms, daggers, cycle chain, rods or any kind of weapon.
- m. Any immoral/unethical activity diminishing institute's reputation.

D. Use of audio equipment is not permissible, however earphones/headphones are allowed.

E. Day Scholars and guests are not allowed in the hostel.

F. The Hostel's dues shall be paid as per the directives of the management.

G. Students are not allowed to be outside the hostel before 6:A.M. and after 9:00 P.M. without prior permission from the warden.

H. Hostels are responsible for keeping their rooms and the common areas in the hostel clean and tidy at all times. Hostel furniture must not be moved without permission of the warden.

I. All fans lights and other electrical appliances must be switched off when not in use.

J. Hostel Management reserves the right to make spot checks of the rooms and the common area without giving prior notice to the students.

K. Hostellers are advised to lock all the doors at all time for security reason. The hostel management is responsible of any loss of private property.

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- L. Hostellers are not permitted to change their room or sleep anywhere else other than in their own room.
- M. Hostel Management reserves the right to change the room of the student if so required.

- N. Pets are not allowed in the hostel premises.
- O. Hostellers are not allowed to keep any vehicle other than bicycle.
- P. Hostellers are not allowed to undertake any part time or full time job or join part time courses without the approval of hostel warden.
- Q. Hostellers have to maintain 75% attendance in the classes. In case the monthly attendance in class falls below 75% the students may be asked to vacate the hostel immediately.
- R. In case of prolonged illness, injury or accident the local guardian shall be responsible to take care of the ward and take him temporarily from the hostel, in case the local guardian fails to take the responsibility of the ward within the stipulated time, the management will not be responsible for the wellbeing of the student.
- S. In case of change of local guardian or change of contact details/address of local guardian/parents, the hostel warden should be informed in writing by the students.
- T. Any assignment/duties as assigned by the hostel warden must be completed as instructed.
- U. Students must adhere to the timing and uniform code of the dining room.
- V. Carrying food or beverage outside the dining hall is not permitted.
- W. The Hostel Management reserves the right to revise "The code of conduct" from time to time and changes will be informed in form of notice on the website or hostel notice board. Ignorance of rules will not be accepted.
- X. Night time will be observed from 2200 hrs to 0530 hrs. During this time all hostellers have to be silent and to be in their respective rooms.
- Y. All outdoor sports must be played in designated area/Court.

Timings for Sport:

- Week Days : 1800 hrs to 2000 hrs.
- Weekends : 1000 hrs. to 1300 hrs. And 1700 hrs to 2000hrs.

4. Punishment

Ignorance of rules will not be accepted. Depending up on the nature and gravity of the offense as established by the committee of the institution, the possible punishment for those found guilty of violating any code of conduct shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- a. Suspension/ Expulsion from the hostel.
- b. Cancellation of admission
- c. Rustication from the institution
- d. Debarring from admission in the hostel in future
